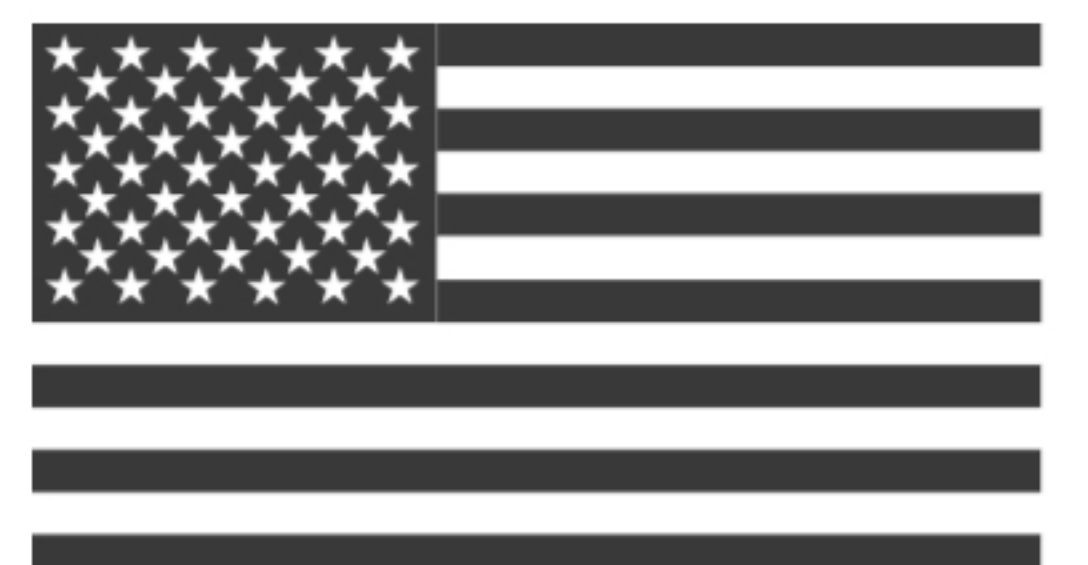

JR & Co. ownership quickly responded to their needs, assembling a crew and donating time and material to ensure that operations could continue for Relentless Pursuit. Our friends at Midwest Supply and Versico have both generously stepped up and have donated the entire roof package that we will be installing later this Spring once construction is complete. This month, our team covered the importance of fall protection. According to OSHA, “Falls are the number one cause of fatalities in construction. Falls cause one of every three construction worker deaths. These falls happen in a split second while workers are on roofs, scaffolds, ladders, bridges, and other work surfaces. But these deaths can be prevented.”

In 2020 we were thrilled to work with Chicken N Pickle on their flagship Kansas City location to add over 2,900 square feet of sheet metal to their exterior as well as assist them in roofing their former outdoor patio area. Our sheet metal department delivered solutions that spanned both their decorative and functional needs. Corrugated metal provided a raw aesthetic to their outdoor games center that helps speak to the brand's relaxed and fun environment. Our metal wall panels created

a pop of color with Chicken N Pickle's signature green while still maintaining the functionality of the building envelope. On the roofing side, we first removed all decking and pavers, then reinstalled them after the patio area was ready to be covered. Our team also installed screen walls with a stunning decorative wood finish to conceal the rooftop units.
